MOUTH CANCER

Mouth cancer has grown by a third in the last decade and remains one of the very few cancers predicted to increase further in the coming years. It can develop in any part of the mouth including the tongue, gums, tonsils, lips and upper part of throat.

What to look out for:

- An ulcer or sore in your mouth or on your tongue that isn't healing after 3 weeks
- A red or white patch in your mouth
- An unexplained pain in your mouth or ear

Lumps and ulcers in the mouth are very common and usually get better on their own. Changes that last longer than 3 weeks should be checked out by your dentist without delay.

Risk Factors

- Tobacco smokers are three times more likely to develop mouth cancer than non-smokers.
- Alcohol the more you cut down on alcohol the more you reduce your risk.
- Age & Gender mouth cancer is typically more common in men and is rare in people under 40. However research has shown that it is now becoming more common in younger patients and women.
- HPV Infection a common sexually transmitted disease, can increase mouth cancer risk.

Please note that we carry out oral cancer screening at every examination.

White Fillings / Composite Bonding

White fillings are becoming an increasingly popular alternative to silver amalgam. They restore function whilst keeping the natural appearance of the tooth. White fillings come in an array of shades to perfectly match your existing tooth. White fillings can also be used to reshape teeth to help give the patient a different shaped tooth for example a tooth that has been worn down by grinding.

These pictures show how the same teeth look with amalgam and white fillings.

These photos show how white filling material has been used to build up the patients front teeth.

If you would prefer to have a tooth coloured filling or have concerns about the shape etc of your teeth please discuss this with your dentist.
